# **Emergency Management (Metropolitan Fire Service Workers Vaccination) (COVID-19) (Revocation) Direction 2022**

under section 25 of the *Emergency Management Act 2004*

## **Preamble**

- 1 On 22 March 2020 I, Grantley Stevens, Commissioner of Police, being State Co-ordinator for the State of South Australia pursuant to section 14 of the *Emergency Management Act 2004* (the *Act*), declared pursuant to section 23 of the Act that a Major Emergency is occurring in respect of the outbreak of the Human Disease named COVID-19 within South Australia.
- 2 Now I, Grantley Stevens, being of the opinion that this is necessary to achieve the purposes of the Act, give the following direction pursuant to section 25 of the Act.

### **1—Short title**

This direction may be cited as the *Emergency Management (Metropolitan Fire Service Workers Vaccination) (COVID-19) (Revocation) Direction 2022*.

### **2—Purpose of this direction**

The purpose of this direction is to revoke the *Emergency Management (Metropolitan Fire Service Workers Vaccination) (COVID-19) Direction 2022*.

### **3—Revocation**

The *Emergency Management (Metropolitan Fire Service Workers Vaccination) (COVID-19) Direction 2022* is revoked.

This direction operates from the 23rd day of May 2022 at 0800 hours
