Emergency Management (Revocation of Certain Directions No 2) (COVID-19) Direction 2022

under section 25 of the Emergency Management Act 2004

Preamble

- On 22 March 2020 I, Grantley Stevens, Commissioner of Police, being State Coordinator for the State of South Australia pursuant to section 14 of the *Emergency Management Act 2004* (the *Act*), declared pursuant to section 23 of the Act that a Major Emergency is occurring in respect of the outbreak of the Human Disease named COVID-19 within South Australia.
- Now I, Grantley Stevens, being of the opinion that this is necessary to achieve the purposes of the Act, give the following direction pursuant to section 25 of the Act.

1—Short title

This direction may be cited as the *Emergency Management (Revocation of Certain Directions No 2) (COVID-19) Direction 2022.*

2—Purpose of this direction

The purpose of this direction is to revoke the—

- (a) Emergency Management (Forensic Science SA Vaccination No 3) (COVID-19) Direction 2022; and
- (b) Emergency Management (Supervised Quarantine No 14) (COVID-19) Direction 2022.

3—Revocation

The following directions are revoked—

- (a) Emergency Management (Forensic Science SA Vaccination No 3) (COVID-19) Direction 2022; and
- (b) Emergency Management (Supervised Quarantine No 14)(COVID-19) Direction 2022.
