## Emergency Management (Western Australian Arrivals Quarantine) (COVID-19) (Revocation) Direction 2021

under section 25 of the *Emergency Management Act 2004*

### Preamble

- 1 On 22 March 2020 I, Grantley Stevens, Commissioner of Police, being the State Co-ordinator for the State of South Australia pursuant to section 14 of the *Emergency Management Act 2004* (the *Act*), declared pursuant to section 23 of the Act that a Major Emergency is occurring in respect of the outbreak of the Human Disease named COVID-19 within South Australia.
- 2 Now I, Grantley Stevens, being of the opinion that this is necessary to achieve the purposes of the Act, give the following directions pursuant to section 25 of the Act.

### 1—Short title

This direction may be cited as the *Emergency Management (Western Australian Arrivals Quarantine) (COVID-19) (Revocation) Direction 2021*.

### 2—Purpose

The purpose of this direction is to revoke previous directions in relation to the quarantine and testing of former Western Australian arrivals.


### 3—Revocation

The following directions are revoked:

- (a) the *Emergency Management (Quarantine and Testing of Certain Western Australian Arrivals) (COVID-19) Direction 2021* (made on 31 January 2021); and
- (b) the *Emergency Management (Modification of Quarantine for Certain Western Australian Arrivals) (COVID-19) Direction 2021* (made on 2 February 2021); and
- (c) the *Emergency Management (Further Modification of Quarantine for Certain Western Australian Arrivals) (COVID-19) Direction 2021* (made on 5 February 2021).
